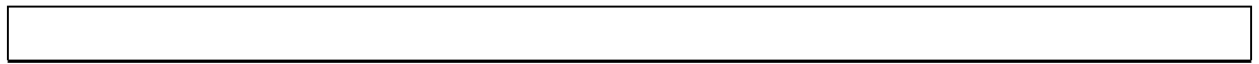
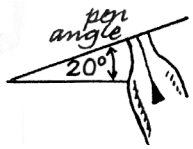


UNCIAL

The name uncial (pronounced “un-shel”) is derived from the Latin word, *uncia*, meaning inch, which may have denoted the height of the original letters. The style has many variations and is a ‘fun’ alphabet to learn.
